



NACHA INC 2011 BioSecurity Policy

The following policy has been put into place by NACHA INC to protect participating horses, owners and the PLA property from infectious viruses' such as the recent EHV-1 virus. **ALL** riders/owners must be willing to adhere to the following requirements to purchase an Entry Form to show:

1. Horses that were at the NCHA Western Nationals in Ogden, UT and/or Kern County Cutting Show in Bakersfield, CA **MUST** strictly follow the quarantine protocol.
2. Horses coming to any NACHA INC event **MUST NOT** have a fever. Check your horse before you leave home. IF your horse seems at all the least bit "off", please leave him at home.
3. There will be **NO** community watering troughs. **ALL** horses **MUST** be watered at their trailers with their own bucket.
4. When using a water hose, **DO NOT** put the hose into the water bucket.
5. Tie horses at their own trailers. **NO** tying to any fences or posts.
6. **DO NOT** allow horses to nose or sniff each other.
7. **DO NOT** allow the public to pet any horses. Please refrain from touching any horse other than your own.
8. Use of hand sanitizers is encouraged (these should contain 62% ethyl alcohol).
9. Please clean up around your trailer and take your manure home with you. *IF it poops, you scoop and haul home.*

ANYTHING that touches an infected horse or carries secretions or manure from sick horses has the potential to transfer pathogens to other horses
